APRIL 4, 2022

Glen 'Butch' Cain called the meeting to order.

<u>Minutes – March 18, 2022</u>

Tim Drenth made a motion to approve, second by Glen 'Butch' Cain. Motion was passed 2-0.

West Shue Open & William Martin

Josh Wiseman was present to request an update on work to be completed on both drains.

West Shue Open – Surveyor Watkins stated that he will send for bids & have them opened at the May 2nd Drainage Board Meeting.

William Martin – Mr. Wiseman asked if this project would be rebid. Surveyor Watkins responded that north of 700 would be sent for bids.

Randy Strasser stated that the survey for this project has been completed and the hydraulic modeling will begin in the next few weeks.

Mr. Carlson requested that Surveyor Watkins create a plan to correct the drainage issue across the south side of 350 to the plug in the road, so that Mr. Carlson may submit a petition to the Drainage Board.

Solar Panels

Surveyor Watkins informed the Board that he was contacted by a landowner with concerns regarding the solar panels that are being presented as a potential project along Highway 24.

Discussion held regarding the landowner's concerns.

Tim suggested that Beau contact County Attorney Patrick Ryan to discuss the landowner's concern.
