Minutes

November 6, 2023

2024 Meeting Dates

After due discussion, Scott made a motion to have the monthly Drainage Board Meeting the first Monday of each month, unless a holiday in which it would be the next business day. Second by Abbey Rossiter. Motion passed 3-0.

Discussion was held regarding the significant change to the scope of work for the contract awarded at the November meeting. Surveyor Watkins informed the Board that he had contacted Dirt Diggers Excavating, Inc. on November 7th and relayed the change to the project and asked them not to start any work.

After due discussion, Scott Carlson made a motion to terminate the contract with Dirt Diggers Excavating, Inc. signed on November 6, 2023, upon mutual agreement due to a significant change to the scope of work. Second by Abbey Rossiter. Motion passed 3-0

Scott Carlson made a motion to request a second Surveyor's estimate and bid as agreed to on November 6, 2023. Second by Abbey Rossiter. Motion passed 3-0.

After due discussion, the Board determined that this project should be rebid. Bids will be accepted on December 13th at 1pm at the Government Center in Morocco.
