<u>Scott Carlson, Drainage Board Chairman</u> - Opened hearing for the Brunton & Decker Lateral Tile (LiDAR).

<u>Steve Snell, County Surveyor</u> – Reviewed proposed reconstruction project.

Public comment was given.

Drainage Board - Discussion and Deliberation

Tim motioned to proceed with the proposed reconstruction assessment in the amount of \$12.40/acre with a \$25.00 annual minimum for a minimum length of 8 yrs. Butch seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Hearing closed.

Scott Carlson opened the regular drainage board meeting.

<u>Contract Awarding – Brunton-Decker Project</u> - Yoder Drainage appeared in person and submitted an adjusted oral bid in the amount of \$122,565.30 for the Decker Lateral Tile Reconstruction project. Tim motioned to accept the bid with oral adjustment from Yoder Drainage in the amount of \$122,565.30 for the Decker Lateral Tile Reconstruction project. Butch seconded the motion and the motion carried 3-0.

<u>Minutes – March 1, 2021</u> - Tim motioned to approve the March 1, 2021 drainage board minutes with a second from Butch. Motion carried 3-0 and minutes were signed.

Progress Reports – Jason Durr, CBBE – Hidden Pines Ph I & Hibler Ph II – 90% done with bid documents on Hidden Pines North Lateral. Continuing with grading plans on Hibler Ph II. Valley Forge – Permit applications have been submitted. Lawler – Ready for surveyor to inspect for tree removal and send notice to bidders. Request from Attorney for Drainage Plan- Discussion. CBBE presented a plan to Newton County in 2014. State (of Indiana) has a Page 1 of 2 water quality manual however has assigned each governmental agency with the responsibility of having plan/ordinance/guidance in place to address stormwater quantity. When ordinance is adopted it should be reviewed every 5 years to update as necessary regarding rainfall totals, etc. LTAP is working in conjunction with Purdue University to publish a model ordinance.

<u>Tile Outlet Cost</u> – Ditch fund will only pay to replace tile outlets when one is damaged while county is maintaining, dipping or excavating a regulated drain. Otherwise it is the responsibility of the landowner to repair/replace outlets from private tiles.

Drake Tile Reconstruction Project – Discussion. Tabled.

Other Matters – Surveyor Snell had been contacted regarding permission to place two (2) culverts in the Rebecca Spitler Ditch to serve as crossovers for a new walking path at the park in Roselawn. Steve had given the dimensions of the pipes that would be necessary. Tim made a motion for the two (2) 24" x 20' pipes to be paid from the regulated Rebecca Spitler ditch fund. Butch seconded the motion and the motion carried 3-0. Jasper County - Candace gave an update on her conversation with Jacob Ahler.

Drenth motioned to adjourn with a second from Cain. Meeting adjourned.
